#### HELLO FROM LISA

"For everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under heaven" Ecclesiastes 3:1

Time is fleeting. We all know that, we all sense it, the seasons come and the seasons go. We mark our lives by the days, the weeks the months and the years. We mark our lives by milestones experienced, and memories we create. If we went by the Chinese calendar, we would be living in the year 4720. The Hebrew calendar year is 5782 and began at sunset on September 6, 2021.

The Persian calendar has been, one of the world's most accurate calendar systems. It's a solar calendar, rather than a lunar one, with the year beginning on midnight of the vernal equinox in Iran. Unlike the Gregorian calendar, which uses a set of mathematical rules to determine when leap years fall, leap years on the Persian calendar are determined by the number of days between the two vernal equinoxes. All this is to say that when we look at the rest of nature, there are no milestones to celebrate or lament. There is no ball dropping in the forest to signify a New Year. No moment to leave

behind past regrets and old memories. No anticipation of what's to come. Nature lives in the now, and moves with the seasons in one seamless flow. What God has rather simply set motion; we have made complicated.

The problem is our issues just don't magically disappear at the flick of a hand on the clock. We wake on January 1st, much like we did on December 31st. This can be depressing for some, but we need to take hope, hope in the promises of God, that he is working all things for our good.

And so the story continues on and on, day after day, chapter after chapter. And it does not end at our last breath, we merely turn the page. My hope for you in this new chapter of our lives is that we live in the present, moment by moment, and seek the light of Jesus in every experience we encounter. God is with us, Immanuel, showing us the way. May your 2022 be filled with light and laughter, hope and promise.
